Minutes of the meeting of Melbourne Parish Council held in the village hall at 6.30pm on Monday 10 July 2023.

- 23/16 Members of the public present None.
- 23/17 Declarations of interest None.
- 23/18 Minutes of the Parish Council meetings held on 15 May 2023 Agreed that the minutes of the meetings be approved as a correct record and be signed by the Chairman.
- 23/19 Matters arising from the minutes:

22/101 – memorial tree – a meeting had taken place at playing field and a location identified for a Tibetan Cherry. A quote had been obtained from Henleys Nurseries for an 8-10ft tree (£70 in total). The Parish Council would buy it now to plant in November which is the optimum planting time. Agreed Clerk to speak to Mrs Taylor to meet to show her the proposed location of the tree.

- g. Cllr Breeze Public Right of Way on East Common Lane been diverted because the original route was impassable. In addition, the stile at the end of the footpath was preventing people with mobility issues/pushchairs etc exiting the footpath. ERYC was aware of the issues **Noted.**
